Tournament Regulations

1) Purpose

MAPLE & KIZUNA (絆) CUP is an annual tennis tournament held each summer in Vancouver BC.

The goal is to promote friendship and for everyone to have fun.

2) Team

Gender Neutral Mixed Doubles.

3) Entry fee

\$100.00/team.

4) Category

Mixed doubles level 7.5 & 8.5.

5) Prize

Prize : \$200 for Winning team from Canawest Creation Co. & \$100 Gift card from T1 Sports for the Second Last team.

5) Match format.

Round-robin.

7.5 : Best of 3 set (Super tie-breaker x 3 set)

8.5 : Best of 3 set (Regular 1 set x 3 set. 3rd set : Super tie-breaker) : **NO-AD SCORING.**

Serve : GENDER TO GENDER

5) Eligibility.

Mixed 7.5 must be the level based on Mixed 7.5.

No 5.0 players allowed (Only 4.5+3.0 or 4.0+3.5)

Mixed 8.5 must be the level based on Mixed 8.5.

No open players allowed (Only 4.5+4.0 or 5.0+3.5 are allowed)

**Tournament committee reserve the right to place players in their appropriate categories.

**The winning team (Champion) will be decided by the total point differential.
(NOT win-loss record)**

**** KIZUNA CARDS ****

You can use **3 kinds of KIZUNA CARD** as below.

① SINGLES COURT

You can play in SINGLE COURT. Opponent is forced to hit back to the single court.

② RACKET EXCHANGE

Your opponent is forced to exchange a racket with the partner.

③ -1 SERVE

Your opponent gets 1 serve instead of 2

****If your opponent misses their first serve, they automatically double fault.**

- ✓ **MUST** call "**KIZUNA CARD**" before you or your opponent serves.
- ✓ **All cards are valid for the next 1 point.**
- ✓ **1 team CANNOT** use 2 cards at the same point.
(Each team CAN use 1 card for the same point. E.g. Team A & B can use the card for the next point)**
- ✓ You **CANNOT** cancel once you called (announced) the card.
- ✓ You do NOT have to use all the cards you get (It's up to you)

- Official ball : Penn Marathon.
- Team captain must check-in 30 minutes before match.
- This tournament is played without a referee attending (Self-judgement).
- In case a retirement occurs when a player is not able to complete a match because of illness, injury, personal emergency or other bona fide reason, the score is as the following.
~ For ex. Team A vs Team B ~
- ** In case of super tie-breaker.
- ** A player of Team A gets injured at the score of 4-1, and he/she retires.

- Please report promptly to the tournament desk in case of injury.
- Only in case a player who retired the previous doubles match because of injury and scheduled to play the next mixed doubles, he/she may be replaced by a substitute player with the opponent's agreement.

- Winning team must report the score after each match and must bring the balls back.
- A maximum of 5 minutes warm-up will be enforced.
- Lateness penalties : will be lost 2 points for every 5 minutes.
- Default after 15 minutes, may be enforced. (Score : 0-6 or 0-10.)

8) Insurance

Maple & Kizuna(縊) cup accepts no responsibility for injury during the tournament.

Please buy your insurance if necessary.

9) Accounting report.

For the use of the entry fee, the accounting report will be sent to the team captain after the tournament.

Both shortfall and excess are carried over to the next year.

10) Postpone & site change.

This is a weather dependable tournament.

Match times may be postponed or delayed and matches may be played on different court surfaces, under lights, or at alternate sites.

Also, match format may be changed.

Please be noted your match(es) may be delayed and finish after 6:00pm.

In case the event is postpone or delay due to rain, it will be notified to the team captain by 6:30am.
