Tournament Regulations

1) Purpose

MAPLE & KIZUNA (絆) CUP is an annual team-based tennis tournament held each summer in Vancouver BC.

The goal is to promote friendship and for everyone to have fun.

2) Team

Minimum 3 men & 3 women are required for one team and maximum 10 players.

3) Entry fee

\$250.00/team. (Early Bird : \$200/team : Registration by the end of June, 2022)

Entry deadline is August 7th, 2021 and after the date no refunds will not be issued.

Final rosters must be submitted by this date and no additions or changes can be made to the list of players.

4) Prize

Prize : \$150 for Winning team & \$100 for Booby team (= Second last place team)

5) Match format.

- 9.0 Men's Doubles x 1
- 8.0 Women's doubles x 1
- 7.0 Mixed Doubles x 1 (**with foam balls**)
- Kizuna singles x 2

No players may play in more than 1 match against each team except KIZUNA SINGLES.

(If you play men's doubles, you cannot play mixed doubles)

The winning team (Champion) will be decided by the total point differential.
(NOT win-loss record)

** POINT CALCULATION**

9.0 Men's doubles, 8.0 Women's doubles, and 7.0 Mixed doubles

👉 Point differential of the super tie-breaker.

KIZUNA Singles

👉 Winning team gets 8 points for each set.

e.g.

9.0 Men's doubles : 10-6, 8.0 Women's doubles : 3-10, 7.0 Mixed doubles : 2-10,

Kizuna Singles 1st set : win (8 points), Kizuna Singles 2nd set : loss (0 point)

Your point differential : -3

** KIZUNA CARDS **

You can use **KIZUNA CARDS** FOR 9.0 Men's Doubles & 8.0 Women's doubles

- ✓ Each team will be presented with **6 KIZUNA CARDS** which will give them an advantage.
- ✓ Before a match, each team **randomly choose 3 out of 6 cards**
(You cannot choose the specific 3 cards)
- ✓ **MUST** call "**KIZUNA CARD**" before you or your opponent serves.
- ✓ **All cards are valid for the next 1 point.**
- ✓ **1 team CANNOT** use 2 cards at the same point.
(** Each team **CAN** use 1 card for the same point. E.g. Team A & B can use the card for the next point)
- ✓ You **CANNOT** cancel once you called (announced) the card.
- ✓ You do NOT have to use all the cards you get (It's up to you)

Here are 6 cards.

① SINGLE COURT

You can play in **SINGLE COURT**. Opponent is forced to hit back to the single court.

② RACKET EXCHANGE

Your opponent is forced to exchange a racket with their partner.

③ SERVE & VOLLEY

Your opponent is forced to serve & volley (or at least move towards the net after the serve).
Partner also has to stay between net and service line until the serving is completed.

④ -1 SERVE

Your opponent gets 1 serve instead of 2
**if your opponent misses their first serve, they automatically double fault.

⑤ WINNERS COUNT X 3

ONLY IF YOU WIN RALLY (volley) WITH A WINNER, you will receive 3 points (**Including service ace)
(In case your opponent wins the point, it counts single)

Winner : In case you hit the ball & your opponent is unable to touch it with his racket before the ball bounces twice.

⑥ NEXT POINT COUNTS X 2

Next point counts double **ONLY IF YOU WIN IT** (In case your opponent wins the point, it counts single)


** If you serve from deuce side and get 2 points, you still have one more serve from ad side.

Men's 9.0 Doubles & Women's 8.0 Doubles

- Super tie-breaker (10 points)
 - 2 serve points each. Team A serves 2 points, then Team B serves 2 points, then Team A serves 2 points again.
 - **Every player starts serve from DEUCE SIDE.**
 - If the score is tied with 9-9, players must win by 2 points.
 - **KIZUNA CARD CAN BE APPLIED.**
 - NO SWITCHING SIDES.
- ** If the match is best of 3 set, switch sides at the beginning of 2nd & 3rd set.**

Mixed 7.0 Doubles

- Mixed 7.0 Doubles is **played with FOAM TENNIS BALL in MINI COURT (court size as below).**
 - Super tie-breaker (10 points)
 - If the score is tied with 9-9, players must win by 2 points.
 - **Every player starts serve from DEUCE SIDE.**
 - Server stands to the right(left) of the center point of the serviceline and serves diagonally across the net to the left(right) side (from the server's perspective) of the court, into the service box.
 - **Serving** can be overarm or underarm and the **serve** may not be volleyed back by the returner.
 - **1 SERVE ONLY.**
 - 2 serve points each. Team A serves 2 points, then Team B serves 2 points, then Team A serves 2 points again.
 - 4 players have to be behind the serviceline until the server hits the ball.
 - **KIZUNA CARDS CAN NOT BE USED.**
 - NO SWITCHING SIDES.
- ** If the match is best of 3 set, switch sides at the beginning of 2nd & 3rd set.**



KIZUNA Singles

- Each team has 6 players (3 men + 3 women) who start with their own rackets.
- Men : maximum 1 x 5.0 player + minimum 1 x 3.5 or below player.**
- Women : maximum 1 x 4.5 player + minimum 1 x 3.5 or below player**

- Play in **SINGLE COURT.**

- **KIZUNA CARD CANNOT BE USED.**

- Each team must decide the order of rotation for their players (The order has to be given to the tournament desk before the match) and keep this order as given to the tournament desk.

- A coin (or a racket) is flipped to determine which team serves first.

- The 1st player from each team **starts serve on the deuce side** and begins the point.

- 1 serve points each. Team A serves 1 point from the deuce side, then Team B serves 1 point from the deuce side, then Team A serves 1 point again from the ad side ** See below for the details.

- After hitting the ball, the player immediately exits the court and the next player in line must hit the next ball.

- Play continues with each team rotating during a single point.

- Once a point is finished, the losing team must remove 1 racket (the racket of the last player on court)

A player without a racket must borrow a teammate's racket when it is available.

e.g.①

Team Kelly's order of players : A – B – C – D – E – F

Team Sally's order of players : 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6

Serve from player A (deuce side)

The point was finished when the player C missed the shot.

Next point (serve) begins from Player 4 from deuce side.

(** NOT from player 3 because 3 was already on court at the last point)

Player C's racket is removed and player D receives the serve (Now Player C is the last player of Team Kelly)

** Player C must borrow the racket from the player D (right after D received the serve)

And the player D must borrow the racket from the player E

** Keep the order of the racket as well.

e.g.②

Team Kelly's order of players : A – B – C – D – E – F

Team Sally's order of players : 1 – 2 – 3 – 4 – 5 – 6

Serve from player A (deuce side)

The point was finished when the player D hit a winner.

Next point (serve) begins from Player 5 from deuce side.

(NOT from player 4 because 4 was already on court at the last point)

Player 4's racket is removed and player 5 serves.

** Player 4 must borrow the racket from the player 5 (right after 5 serves)

And the player 5 must borrow the racket from the player 6.

** Keep the order of the racket as well.

- **The team who knocks out all of their opponent's rackets win and gets 8 points for each set.**

6) Definition & Ineligibility

Mixed 7.0 doubles (with foam ball)

The combined NTRP level of a doubles pair cannot exceed the 7.0 level.

For instance, a 3.0 and a 4.0 can play at the 7.0 level since their combined rating is 7.0.

Be aware that the maximum difference in player ratings for doubles pair is 1.5.

That means that a 2.5 player cannot play with a 4.5 player.

Match is played with FOAM TENNIS BALL in MINI COURT.

Women's 8.0 doubles

The combined NTRP level of a doubles pair cannot exceed the 8.0 level.

For instance, a 3.5 and a 4.5 can play at the 8.0 level since their combined rating is 8.0.

Be aware that the maximum difference in player ratings for doubles pair is 1.5.

That means that a 3.0 player cannot play with a 5.0 player.

Men's 9.0 doubles

Following A) & B) players CANNOT play in Men's 9.0 doubles.

A) 5.0 Players who have won the first round of a main draw in ANY Open categories* in all types of tournaments including non-ranking organized by tennis BC in the past 2 years from 2019 38th annual new year's classic tournament (Victoria BC) **

*Any Open categories : Men's & women's singles & men's & women's doubles and mixed doubles

**Except the first-round walkover

✂Match results up to and including the 2021 Stanley Open will be considered.

B) Player(s) who is considered open or above by the tournament committee.

The combined NTRP level of a doubles pair cannot exceed the 9.0 level.

For instance, a 4.5 and a 4.5 can play at the 9.0 level since their combined rating is 9.0.

Be aware that the maximum difference in player ratings for doubles pair is 1.5.

That means that a 4.0 player can play with a 5.0 player (who is eligible to play).

Again, open player cannot play.

KIZUNA Singles

Men : maximum 1 x 5.0 player + minimum 1 x 3.5 or below player.

Women : maximum 1 x 4.5 player + minimum 1 x 3.5 or below player

7) Play

4 teams

- Round-Robin by 4 teams.
- **The winning team (Champion) will be decided by the total point differential. (NOT win-loss record)**
- 9.0 Men's doubles x 1, 8.0 Women's double x 1, 7.0 Mixed doubles x 1, and KIZUNA Singles x 2.
- Super tie-breaker (10 points) x best of 3 set (Except KIZUNA Singles)
